

## Tech Supply List for K-4

*Please make sure all devices are labeled with student's name.*

### Headphones or Earbuds – All Grades

Make sure these are sturdy and feel comfortable in student's ears.  
(some earbuds hurt little one's ears).

We suggest that you keep them simple and small enough to place in a plastic ziplock baggie with student's name on it.

These do NOT have to be expensive or big. They need to be something easy for students to use throughout the year(s). We have a few used over the head devices to lend students as needed.



### Mice

**\*NOTE:** Our new computer devices are touch screen, and students have an option to use the touchpad, touchscreen and/or a mouse. Here at WRS, we would like students to have a mouse as their first option in learning about computers. Student computers remain at school in a locked cabinet.

**Wired vs wireless:** Wireless mice are popular, but students will need to learn how to store the little receiver. Students *will* have their own device, so the receiver can be left in their computer most of the time.



**Kindergarten:** Do not need mice at this level.

**TP-1st:** Our wonderful Home and School have granted us mini wired mice throughout the years so we have some for most of TP and 1<sup>st</sup> graders or students who can't purchase their own. If this grade level wants to bring their own mouse from home, that's OK too!



### **\*Grades 2 through 4:**

See **\*NOTE** above. Students at this grade level should provide their own wired/wireless mouse. Make sure the devices are labeled with their name and has a working battery in the wireless device. These can be stored in a baggie with their headphones. The receiver can stay in their computers, as they will each have their own to use during the school year.



**We can provide headphones and mice for those who cannot purchase them.**
